For example, you may wish to alter the *Order of Worship* resource to better suit the context of your community, or you may draw inspiration from the WPCU materials to create something entirely new. Communities should also feel free to use the WPCU materials not only during the traditional Week of Prayer for Christian Unity (January 18-25 in the northern hemisphere), but throughout the year, to pray for Christian unity and to foster ecumenical fellowship and service.

The Armenian ecumenical group which created this year’s WPCU service has provided music for several key points in the liturgy, but local organizers may choose to use different music, or to add an opening and/or closing hymn from among the resources listed below, which are either connected with the readings or more loosely related to the themes of light, unity, and justice. A suggestion for chanting the verses of the candle-lighting hymn appears at the end of this document.

The verses of the **candle-lighting hymn** may simply be read (in between the sung refrains) or chanted to a pattern like the following:



Ageless, uncreated God, / Father, Lord of all; /
 heed our prayers, the earnest pleas / of those serving you. *Looy's*.

From the Father, wondrous Dawn, / just and righteous Sun; /
 rise, shine forth upon us all, / kind and tender Light. *Looy's*.

Spirit pouring from the Father, / wellspring of the good; /
 fill us with your radiant Light / in this new day's morn. *Looy's*.

Persons three, in nature one, / one Divinity; /
 we confess you at all times – / Holy Trinity. *Looy's*.

Refrain: (“*Looy's*” is pronounced like “*Luis*”).
